It is with pride and joy that we can give these greetings! Christian Care Home has been under the same ownership since its beginning in 1911. We have seen changes of ownership with so many nursing homes, although we have changed locations, we are still under the same ownership.

It was August 21st, 2010 that we watched as our residents began to settle into their new home and began to make new friends and engage in various activities. The lounge areas provide a common place for social gatherings and conversations. With the existence of long well lighted hallways, there is added opportunity for walking exercises and greetings. We enjoy seeing "our family" sitting in the patio areas watching as workers maintain the landscape.

Our residential care unit maintains a comfortable lounge area with an electric fireplace, private dining room, a self-serve laundry, with each semi-private room having it's own bathroom that includes a shower with bench.

We now have an offer to all new residential center residents for a price reduction in their first year with us.

The beautiful chapel with stained glass windows provides a relaxed setting for worship and meditation. Our chaplain, Richard Applegate, provides a source of comfort and encouragement with the room full of folks in attendance at worship and midweek Bible Study. Other groups of different faiths are welcome and also provide music and encouragement for our residents.

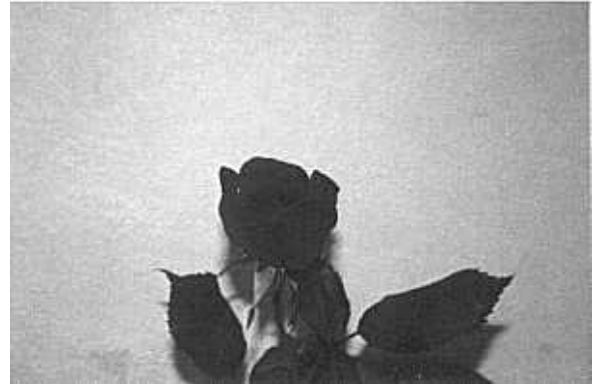
